It is submitted by the learned counsel for the

petitioner that the petitioner has no concern, in any manner, with the alleged offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case and the entire allegation is confined against Md. Suleman.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has submitted that from perusal of the impugned order passed by the learned Sessions Judge it would appear that in course of investigation it transpired that the another accused who accompanied Md. Suleman was the petitioner. It would also be evident that after being arrested the petitioner confessed his guilt before the police and stated that it was he who was accompanying Md. Suleman on the relevant date of occurrence.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, considering the gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner in connection with Madhubani Town P.S. Case No. 201 of 2016 giving rise to Sessions Trial No. 203 of 2016 pending in the court of the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Madhubani. Accordingly, his application for bail is rejected.
