counsel representing the State.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer of bail, which was earlier rejected vide order dated 02.03.2016 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 55764 of 2015, on the ground that the petitioner is in custody since 14.09.2015, three prosecution witnesses have been examined and all have turned hostile and did not support the prosecution case, there was no intention to commit murder and, as such, the petitioner deserves sympathetic consideration to which learned APP seriously opposes by submitting that the petitioner shot the informant which hit just below his right chest and injury has been found by the doctor which was dangerous to life.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, finding no good ground for reconsideration of prayer for bail of the

petitioner, again his prayer for bail stands rejected.

However, considering the period of detention, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same as early as possible, preferably within four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, failing which the petitioner, if at no fault may be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
