ORAL ORDER

2 26-10-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 328 and 394 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Earlier this Court vide order dated 11.4.2016 passed in
Cr. Misc. No.7457 of 2016 rejected the prayer for bail of the
petitioner with a liberty to renew his prayer for bail after
completion of one year in jail custody.

The petitioner is in jail since 10.9.2015 and he has
already completed one year in jail custody.

In this view of the matter, let petitioner, Barun @ Barun
Kumar Yadav @ Barun Kumar, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two

sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahgalpur in connection with Sahkund (Sajour) P.S. Case No. 111 of 2015, subject to the conditions that (i) one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner i.e. father, mother, wife or son (ii) If the petitioner is found involved in future in similar type of case the prosecution will be at liberty to make prayer for cancellation of his bail and the court below will pass necessary order including cancellation of bail (iii) Petitioner shall mark his presence before the nearest police station by 7th of every month till six months and (iv) petitioner would participate in the court proceeding and in the event of being absent on two consecutive dates, the court below will be at liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
