2      04-02-2016                      The petitioner is informant of Minapur P.S. Case No.61 of 2013 under sections 420, 406 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code. By way of the present application under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, he seeks a direction to be issued to the respondents to conclude the investigation of the aforesaid police case and submit charge-sheet against the accused persons named in the FIR within three months.
