Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case instituted under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 47(a)/50 of the Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

Allegation against petitioners is that from the bush of Shisham tree, which is of petitioners, Mahua wine has been recovered

It has been submitted on behalf of petitioners that they are in custody since 8.7.2016. They have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses against petitioners. Recovery is said to have been made from the orchard. There is no compliance of Section 100 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dehri, Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Dehri P.S. Case no. 352 of 2016.
