learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 25(1-b)A/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Two motorcycles were apprehended on suspicion
to be stolen property, one was being driven by the petitioner.

Submission is that nothing else was recovered
from the possession of the petitioner. The said motorcycle was in
the name of the father of the petitioner; hence, the same has
already been released in favour of the father of the petitioner.
Arms were recovered from another motorcycle rider.
