ORAL ORDER

2 09-12-2016 After some argument, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, in presence of the learned G.P. 20, appearing on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 to 4, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the prescribed revisional authority under the provisions of The Bihar Land Reforms (Fixation of Ceiling Area and Acquisition of Surplus Land) Act, 1961 for grant of appropriate relief(s) to the petitioner with respect to the impugned appellate order passed by the respondent Additional Collector, Araria as also with respect to the lands in question.

Permission is accorded.



The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
