This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioner, namely, Chandan Mandal @ Chandar Mandal, in connection with Sessions Trial No.289 of 2016, arising out of Bhairav Asthan P.S. Case No.17 of 2016, under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the above application and materials on record.

Heard Mr. Vinay Ranjan, learned Counsel for the petitioner, and Md. Aslam Ansari, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

In view of the fact that the accused above-named



has been in custody since 24.05.2016 in connection with the case
aforementioned and though *charge sheet* has been submitted,
trial has not yet commenced, similarly situated co-accused have
been granted bail by a Bench of this Court by the order, dated
30.08.2016, passed in Cr. Misc. No.26893 of 2016, and perusal
of the materials available does not reveal such incriminating
materials, which would warrant further detention of the accused-
petitioner in custody, and in view also of the fact that the perusal
of the materials does not reveal that the accused-petitioner's
liberty on bail would adversely affect his trial, it is, in the interest
of justice, hereby directed that the accused above-named shall be
released on bail of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties, each of the like
amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Additional
Sessions Judge-VII, Madhubani, in connection with Sessions
Trial No.289 of 2016, arising out of Bhairav Asthan P.S. Case
No.17 of 2016.

This direction for bail is further subject to the
condition that the accused above-named shall not, directly or
indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person
acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from
disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or

tamper with the evidence and shall appear, in the learned Court below, as may be directed.

In terms of the above observations and directions, this bail application shall stand disposed of.
