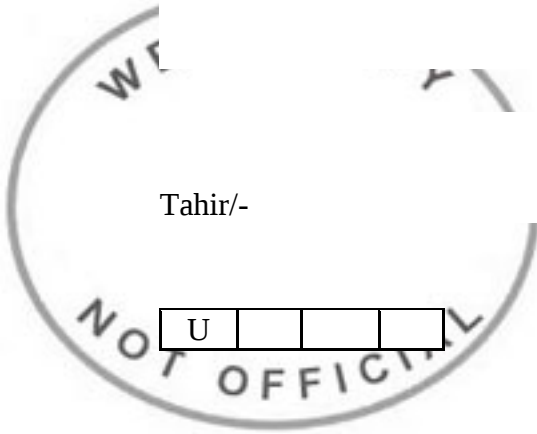
After some argument, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, in presence of learned AC to SC 15, appearing on behalf of the respondent no. 1, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the prescribed revisional authority under the provisions of The Bihar Land Mutation Act, 2011 for grant of appropriate relief(s) to him with respect to lands in question as also the orders impugned.

The writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
