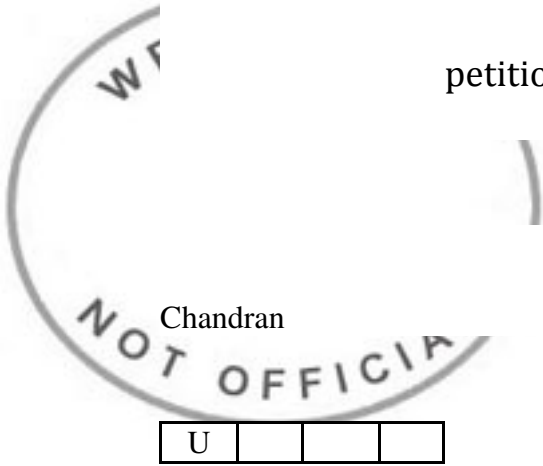
CORAM: HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE VIKASH JAIN
