In this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India, the legality of the order dated 27.12.2013
(Annexure-6) passed by the respondent Sub-Divisional Officer has
been challenged. By the said order, the Sub-Divisional Officer
directed for unlocking the door of the room so that the same would
handed over to applicant-respondent no. 9.

Counsel for the State has pointed out with reference to the statement made in the counter affidavit that the petitioner has already filed a title suit in respect to the subject matter of the present case.
