122 bottles Indian made foreign liquor were recovered
from a tempo, which was being driven by co-accused Ajeet Singh,
and at the time of aforesaid recovery, one person managed to flee
away from the place of occurrence.

Submission on behalf of the petitioner is that as a matter
of fact, petitioner was simply passenger of the tempo. It is also
submitted that tempo driver, namely, Ajeet Singh as well as one
co-accused Uday Singh have already been granted privilege of
bail by different Benches of this Court

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two

sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief
Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Vishnupad P.S.Case
No. 77 of 2016.
