Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner

Mr. Bibhuti Prasad Pandey at the very outset fairly states that for the most part, the prayers in the writ petition have now become infructuous as the time contemplated under the relevant permit have since elapsed. He invites attention to the representation dated 13.10.2014 (Annexure-3) which has been filed before the

Principal Secretary-cum-State Transport Commissioner,
