An issue like this would not be gone into by the Writ Court as the petitioner has a remedy under common law. What has been complained is against the construction of a Community Hall (Samudayik Bhawan). In the submission of the counsel for the petitioner if the construction is made thereover, his approach shall be obstructed. On the other hand, the stand of the State respondent is that upon donation of the land the construction has

been made.

Mr. Prasad, the counsel for the petitioner, after making submission at some length, prays for disposal of the case permitting the petitioner to represent his grievance before the appropriate forum/authority in accordance with law.

Granting the said liberty, the writ application is disposed of.
