By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek quashing of the first information report (for short “the FIR”) of Samastipur (Town) P. S. Case No. 26 of 2015 registered under Sections 304-B, 328, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State and perused the FIR as contained in Annexure-1 to the present application. The allegations made therein do attract the ingredients of a cognizable offence.

In that view of the matter, I do not find any merit in this application. Accordingly, it is dismissed.
