Submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the

of the petitioner and even if the story, as propounded by the

informant, is assumed to be true, then also , there is nothing on

the record to show that the seized liquor belongs to the petitioner.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be

released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two

sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Railway
Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Bettiah, West Champaran in
connection with Raxaul Rail P.S.Case No. 08 of 2016.
