By the order dated 9.10.2012 passed in CWJC No.

13989 of 2012 the opposite parties were directed to consider and

dispose of the post retiral claim of the petitioner by passing

speaking order.

In the show cause filed on behalf of the opposite



parties, it is stated that all the post retiral dues have already been paid to the petitioner, the details of which are also mentioned in the show cause.

In the aforesaid view of the matter, the order under contempt stands complied with. The contempt application is, accordingly, dismissed.
