This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioner, namely, Amarjeet Sahni @ Indrajeet Sahni, in connection with Mahua Police Station Case No. 425 of 2013, under Sections 363/365 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the above application and materials on record.

Heard Mr. Devendra Kumar, learned Counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. S. M. Rahman, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

Mr. Devendra Kumar, learned Counsel, submits that the petitioner above-named was initially arrested in connection with Dalsingsarai Police Station Case No. 130 of 2016, under Section 27(1-b) a of the Arms Act, 1959, and

the petitioner has been remanded in connection with the present case on 04.03.2016.

In view of the above submission and the fact that the accused above-named has been in custody since 04.03.2016 in connection with the case aforementioned and though *charge sheet* has been submitted and perusal of the materials available on record does not reveal such incriminating materials, which would warrant further detention of the accused-petitioner in custody, and in view also of the fact that the perusal of the materials does not reveal that the accused-petitioner's liberty on bail would adversely affect his trial, it is, in the interest of justice, hereby directed that the accused above-named shall be released on bail of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties, each of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali, at Hajipur, in connection with Mahua Police Station Case No. 425 of 2013.

This direction for bail is further subject to the condition that the accused above-named shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence and shall appear, in the learned Court below, as may be directed.

In terms of the above observations and directions, this bail application shall stand disposed of.
