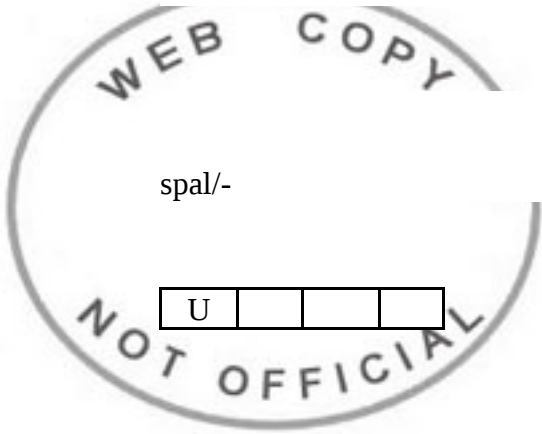

ORAL ORDER

4 22-09-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the BSFC and for the State.

An additional show cause has been filed today on behalf of the Managing Director, Bihar State Financial Corporation, in which it is stated that the possession of the mortgaged/hypothecated assets of the petitioner, M/s. Shyam Cold Storage, Ghorasahan, East Champaran was handed over to the petitioner and was taken over by its partner on 16.9.2016, as contained in the report of the Branch Manager, BSFC. The aforesaid fact is admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner.
