direction to the State-respondents to upgrade the Middle School

Main, in the district of Gaya, to Secondary School and also for

direction to complete the construction work of the road situated between Makhdumpur and Tekari via Pai Bigha and Main, which has been undertaken by Road Construction Department, Bihar, for upgradation.

It, however, now, transpires that the school, in question, has already been upgraded to secondary school and the construction of the road, in question, is also in progress.

In view of the above, this writ petition is closed with direction to respondent No.4, namely, Principal Secretary, Department of Road Construction, Government of Bihar, Patna, to ensure expeditious completion of the construction of the road in question. We also give the petitioner liberty to approach this Court with appropriate application, in future, if situation so warrants.
