Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Vishnupad P.S. Case No.83 of 2015,
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363,
366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The statement of the girl recorded under Section 164 of the
Criminal Procedure Code itself indicates the nature of relation
with the petitioner.

Looking to the nature of allegation and the facts and
circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners in the
event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today be

released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Vishnupad P.S. Case No.83 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
