2 30-06-2016 Heard Sri Binay Kumar, learned counsel for the

petitioner and Sri Arun Kumar Pandey, learned Addl. Public

Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, apprehending her arrest in
Fatehpur P.S. Case no.62 of 2016 registered for the offence under
Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act and Section 406 of the
Indian Penal Code, has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a P.D.S. dealer and is a widow lady. He submits that
she has been falsely implicated in the present case and about 4
Quintals of wheat was shown to be recovered alleging violation of
provision of Section 7 of the E.C.Act.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has opposed the
prayer of the petitioner.

However, considering the nature of accusation and the fact that the petitioner is a lady , let the petitioner, namely, Subhadra Devi, in the event of her arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case no.62 of 2016 , subject to condition as laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
