The question of grant of A.C.P. is another issue for which petitioner can assert his right and the same will be considered and decided in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months. So far as pension etc. is concerned, it seems that the same has now been authorized by the Accountant General as is the stand taken in the counter affidavit. If any other legitimate claim remains,

petitioner is free to approach the authority for its redressal.

Writ stands disposed of with observation as above.
