If the opening, which has been given to the petitioner, is not acceptable to the petitioner, he is free to join the job market and try his capability and ability for employment. The Court will not pass any order in favour of the petitioner for change of his job or the post when the Full Bench decision has already upheld the policy on which the petitioner has been given employment or engagement on compassionate ground.

Writ is dismissed.
