The only reason why the Court is not willing to pass any order for appointment of the petitioner at this belated stage is that the rules have undergone a change and now nobody is going to be appointed on the post of a Teacher including Panchayat Teacher etc. without passing the Teacher Eligibility Test.

This is not to certify or give a seal of approval to anybody and everybody's act in the present case to be a precedent and ignore a decision or direction issued by the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority because every authority is bound to

implement the decision or direction unless interfered or set aside by a superior forum. The Court is not happy with the manner in which the things have been done by the subordinate or superior authorities in this regard.

Writ is dismissed.
