The Full Bench decision of this Court, rendered in the case of **State of Bihar and others Vs. Rajeev Ran Vijay Kumar**, reported in **2010(3) PLJR 294**, has not been interfered with or set aside till yet, with regard to the policy on compassionate appointment and the opening to which a claimant of former teachers are entitled to.
