3 26-09-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is the *Gotani* of the deceased lady and
is apprehending her arrest in a case registered under Section
304B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is also the first cousin sister of the deceased who had
been opposing the love marriage between the deceased and her
husband Diwakar Mandal and, therefore, there was an
animosity existent between them and it is for the said reason,
that her name was brought into the present case.

Having considered the nature of allegations and that
the present petitioner stands in a similar situation as the

deceased is one of the daughters-in-law in the family, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Naugachia, District-Bhagalpur, in connection with Parbatta P.S. Case No.17 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
