The petitioner prays for his retiral benefits.

A counter affidavit has been filed stating that retiral dues of the petitioner has been paid.

However, I find that G.I.C. amount has not been paid to the petitioner.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, respondent Nos.3 and 4 would take appropriate steps so that G.I.C.

amount is paid and credited to the petitioner’s account within a period of three months.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, this writ application stands disposed of.
