Claim of the petitioner for grant of second A.C.P. has been considered and rejected on the ground that he has not completed the length of service in terms of the requirement of MACP Rules, which is in existence now.

Since the right of the petitioner flows from the statutory provisions so notified and if he fails to meet the yardstick, he cannot get the benefit only on the length of stagnation because it is also linked to the length of service.

Writ has no merit. It is dismissed.
