Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

This revision application has been filed for setting aside the judgment dated 1.9.2015 passed by the Sessions Judge, Buxar in Criminal Appeal (J.B.) No.37 of 2015, by which he has affirmed the order dated 9.7.2015 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Buxar, by which he has refused to release the Petitioner in J.J.B. No.575 of 2015 arising out of Buxar Muffasil P.S. case No.78 of 2015.

Considering the antecedents of the Petitioner, I would not think it proper to release him since there is every possibility of him mingling with anti social elements.

The application stands dismissed.

The Juvenile Justice Board, Buxar is directed to conclude the proceedings positively within a period of six months from the date of receipt of this order without granting unnecessary adjournments to any party, for which reason he shall send a list of the witnesses fixing specific dates for each witnesses for their examination along with a copy of this order to the S.P., Buxar, who is directed to ensure the attendance of the witnesses on the date fixed by the Trial Court so that there is no further delay in the trial.
