2 01-09-2016 I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered
for offences punishable under Sections 304, 420 and 120(B) of
the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation, informant's daughter has
delivered a baby child who survived whereas the mother died in
course of treatment. Allegation is that there was negligence during
operation. It is contended that the person who is running the
nursing home has already been granted bail by a co-ordinate
Bench of this Court vide Annexure 5 and petitioner is a lady.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the petitioner, namely, Shilu Sinha @ Dr. Madam be

released on bail in the event of arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today in Nawada Town P.S. Case No. 442 of 2014, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand Rupees) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section(2) of Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Further, the petitioner shall present herself before the police/court as and when required and in the event of failure on her part to appear before the court on two consecutive occasions, her bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
