learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sankarpur P.S. Case No.6 of 2014 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Case No.6 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
