2. Learned counsel for the respondents, Mr. Anil Kumar Sinha, submits that the amount of Rs. 50,548/- was imposed in the nature of fine and was well within the authority of the respondents. It is further submitted that the amount in question has admittedly been deducted from the Product Account of Distributor as evident from para-1 of the writ petition itself, in view of which the writ petition is

largely infructuous.
