Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Runisaidpur P.S.Case No. 62/2015, disclosing offences under
sections 498A, 323, 379, 364 of the Indian Penal Code and
sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

It transpires from the submissions advanced on behalf of
the parties that the trial arising out of concerned Runisaidpur
P.S.Case No. 62/2015 has commenced and two witnesses have
already been examined.

Considering the fact that the trial has commenced, I am

not inclined to grant the petitioner privilege of regular bail.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, if there is no substantial progress in the trial, the petitioners shall be at liberty to renew his prayer for regular bail after six months.
