Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks revision of the order dated
27.4.2013 passed by the Additional District & Sessions Judge-I,
Nalanda, Biharsharif, in Sessions Trial No. 308 of 2002.

I find from the impugned order dated 27.4.2013 passed
by the Additional District & Sessions Judge-I, Nalanda, Biharsharif,
in Sessions Trial No. 308 of 2000 that it was at a very belated stage,
the Petitioner filed a claim for being a juvenile and previously, the
Petitioner had already been refused such a prayer after due enquiry.

The impugned order reveals the case was pending for
hearing since 2.7.2012 and for the next more than two years, it was
not heard.

I am surprised at the attitude of the Trial Judge who did not think it serious to dispose off the Trial for 2 years. The application stands rejected without further indulgence.
