Four petitioners have approached this Court by filing the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer to quash an order of cognizance, which was passed long back on 28.09.2010 in Suryapura P.S. Case no.59/2010, whereby after submission of chargesheet, the learned Magistrate has taken cognizance of offence under Section 307 and other allied Sections of the Indian Penal Code as well as Section 27 of the Arms Act.
