ORAL ORDER

2 19-10-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Araria (Bairgachhi) P.S. Case No. 526 of 2001 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation of informant is that Hajari Lal Bhagat and Kamla Prasad Bhagat, cousin of the informant, sold the land of his share along with their mother in favour of the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are bona fide purchaser of the land, which is said to be in the share of the informant. Moreover, the dispute, as alleged in the complaint petition, is of civil in nature.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M., Araria in connection with Araria (Bairgachhi) P.S. Case No. 526 of 2001, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
