Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case instituted under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against petitioners is that they have killed daughter of informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they have got no criminal antecedent. No allegation of tampering of witnesses is alleged against petitioners. Petitioner no. 1 is father-in-law of the deceased and petitioner nos. 2 and 3 are dewars of the deceased. The police has submitted final form against petitioners. Subsequently, the court below has taken cognizance for offence under Section 304B of the Indian Penal Code. Petitioners are separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan, in connection with Nautan P.S. Case no. 164 of 2012, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
