The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Kankarbagh P.S. Case No.199 of 2000 registered under Sections 448, 341, 324, 307 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Regard being had to the fact that the case is of the year 2000 and charge-sheet has been submitted in the year 2008 showing the petitioners as absconder, I am not inclined to grant them pre-arrest bail in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in the matter of *Lavesh vs. State (NCT of Delhi)*, (2012)8 SCC 730.

Accordingly, the application for grant of anticipatory

bail is rejected.
