2 24-10-2016 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner being the husband of the complainant is apprehending arrest in a complaint case filed for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 406, 498A, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act wherein process has been directed to be issued after cognizance being taken.

As per the complaint petition, the complainant was married to the petitioner on 05.05.2013, but subsequent to the marriage rupees two lakh was demanded as further dowry demand and for non-fulfillment of the same, the complainant was abused and assaulted. The impugned order reflects that the petitioner gave threatening to the brother of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner admits his marriage with the complainant and he is ready to keep the complainant as wife with full dignity and honour. A statement to that effect has been made in para 10 of the petition which reads as follows:-

"That petitioner is ready to keep his wife/complainant with all due respect and dignity in accordance with his economic condition."

It is further submitted that similar was the stand of the petitioner before the learned Court below.

Considering the present stand of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on provisional anticipatory bail for six months in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Dehri, in connection with Complaint Case No.211C/2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Let the learned court below issue notice to the complainant for her appearance. On her appearance, the petitioner will take the complainant to keep her as wife with full

dignity and honour.

The provisional bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by learned court below in three eventualities (i) if the matrimonial harmony is substantially restored (ii) if the complainant fails to appear before the learned court below or (iii) if the complainant gets reluctant to reconcile the issue.
