ORAL ORDER

3 23-11-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sirdalla P.S. Case No.2 of 2016 for allegedly having committed the offences under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that admittedly, the main allegation is against Rajendra Yadav and not against these two petitioners. The present petitioners have assaulted the informant with *Lathi*. The injuries purported to have been inflicted have been found to be simple in nature.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let both the petitioners, above named, in the

event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of ₹10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada, in connection with Sirdalla P.S. Case No.2 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
