The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Bodh Gaya P.S. Case No.279 of 2014 registered under Sections
382, 387, 147, 148, 448. 379 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner has not been shown as accused in the
accused column in the complaint petition, which is the basis of the

being the broker managed to sanction the house loan of

the persons, who entered the house of the complainant/informant and looted the ornaments and other households articles from there. Moreover, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and the circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender by him within six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Bodh Gaya P.S. Case No.279 of 2014, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
