Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for
offences punishable under Sections 33B, 41 and 42 of the Forest
Act.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the
petitioner and the tractor from which stone chips were recovered
does not belong to the petitioner and the petitioner has no criminal
antecedent.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and
circumstances of the case, this application is allowed. Let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Gaya, in connection with Forest P.S. Case No. 34 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
