From the pleadings of the petitioner it does not emerge whether the college in question is affiliated or constituent college of Magadh University. In absence of the above status, the matter of non-payment of salary to the petitioner is a matter between him and the private managing committee of privately managed institution.

Writ application, therefore, is dismissed. However, dismissal of the writ will not come in the way of petitioner by invoking common law remedy.
