vacancies have been consumed in the subsequent selection.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one
contempt matter is pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court but the
contempt has nothing to do with the substantive proceedings.

Accordingly, this writ application is dismissed on account of delay.

However, if an order is passed in the contempt matter which is in favour of the petitioner, in that case, the petitioner will have also a liberty to extract benefit from that order.
