Mr. Mrigank Mauli, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Y.V.Giri, learned senior counsel for the respondent-National Institute of Technology (NIT) appearing along with Mr. Sanjay Kumar Giri, Advocate on record for the respondent, upon instruction from their respective clients submit that they are willing to have the matter referred to arbitration.

They further submit that both the parties are agreed that the arbitration be held by Mr. Justice Jayanandan Singh, a former Judge of this Court.
