Heard Mr. Ajit Kumar, learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the petitioner and Mr. S.D. Sanjay, learned senior counsel
for the respondents.

Although the petitioner questions oral order of
termination dated 14.10.2008 relying upon a recruitment order dated
31.8.1997 to submit that the petitioner has been arbitrarily removed
from service but in view of the position explained at Annexure-A to
the counter affidavit read alongside the period of work discharged by
the petitioner vide Annexure-2/1, no enforceable right accrues to the
petitioner for maintaining the writ petition. Even otherwise in absence



of any formal appointment order and in absence of any document to confirm his stand reflecting in paragraph-21 of having worked from 19.5.1988 to 14.10.2008, the relief prayed in the writ petition is devoid of merit and the writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
