Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

According to the prosecution case itself, petitioner was arrested from his house and except mobile set nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession. Although the informant claims in the first informant report that petitioner carries criminal antecedent but para-3 of the petition shows that petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent.
