Heard.

Petitioner is said to have main assailant of the deceased and, earlier, his prayer for bail was rejected vide order dated 03.04.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 9784 of 2015 by this Court.

The trial court vide its letter no. 124 dated 22.03.2016 reported that six prosecution witnesses including informant, I.O. and doctor have been left to be examined but learned counsel appearing for the informant says that only I.O. and doctor have been left to be examined and other prosecution witnesses have already been examined.

Considering the aforesaid submission of the learned

counsel for the informant, I do not feel it proper to release the petitioner on bail in connection with Sessions Trial No.53 of 2015, arising out of Dandari P.S.Case No. 59 of 2014, pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge-VIII, Begusarai and, hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner stands rejected, at least, at this stage..

However, if the trial of the petitioner is not concluded by the trial court within three months from the date of receipt/ production of copy of this order, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail before the learned trial court itself.
