Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to make appropriate correction in the cause title of the writ petition with regard

to designation of respondent no. 3. Let the same be done during the course of the day.

The petitioners have moved the Court for a direction to the respondents to give them further time to get online enrolment done and also for not cancelling their licences.

Today, learned counsel submits that they have filed petition before the respondent no. 2 praying for such relief, which has still not been disposed off.
